



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING



KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

This Memorandum of Understanding is entered into and executed by and between

AMIKOM PURWOKERTO UNIVERSITY, a private educational institution registered under the laws of Indonesia, with address at Jl. Letjen Pol Soemarto, Purwanegara-Purwokerto Utara, Kabupaten Banyumas 53127, represented herein by its Rector, **Dr. Berlilana, M.Kom., M.Si.**, hereinafter referred to as "AMIKOM",

and

MISAMIS UNIVERSITY, a private educational institution registered under Philippines laws, with principal office at H.T. Feliciano Street, Ozamiz City, represented by its President, **DR. KAREN BELINA F. DE LEON**, hereinafter referred to as "MU".

WITNESSETH: That

WHEREAS, AMIKOM and MU agree to enter into a formal partnership agreement based on the foundation of mutual trust for the mutual benefit and development of the two institutions and the promotion of international understanding and good will.

NOW THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing premises, the parties hereby agree as follows:

ARTICLE I DESCRIPTION OF COOPERATION

The two institutions resolve to exercise reasonable efforts to promote the following programs:

- (1) Exchange of Students
- (2) Exchange of faculty, staff, and researchers
- (3) Exchange of academic information and publications
- (4) Joint research activities
- (5) Short term program participation
- (6) Joint organizers of international lectures, fora, symposia and research conferences
- (7) Other exchanges of academic and cultural nature agreed upon by both parties

ARTICLE II MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS

1. Each party agrees and covenants to the other that it shall enter into negotiations in good faith.
2. Both parties warrant that they have the capacity and resources to assume their respective responsibilities outlines in this Understanding.

3. Both parties undertake to inform each other of any and all new information and developments, which would have an impact on the negotiations.
4. In the event that their party sends representatives to the other party in the furtherance of this Understanding, the sending party shall pay for the travel cost of its representatives. The host party shall pay for the accommodation and meals of the representative during the duration of the visit.
5. All notices required or permitted under this Understanding shall be in writing and transmitted to the addressee by registered address indicated in the party clause hereof. A party hereto may cause a change in its address by serving a written notice of such fact to the other. A notice of change of address shall be binding on the Other Party immediately upon receipt of such notice.



This Understanding may be amended, modified or otherwise altered only by means of a written instrument duly signed by all parties.



ARTICLE III TERM

The Understanding shall be valid for a period of three (3) year commencing on the date this instrument is signed and executed, unless sooner terminated by either of both parties as provided herein below.

The parties shall utilize the period to discuss the specific terms and conditions of their collaboration.

ARTICLE IV TERMINATION

It is hereby agreed that either party may terminate the Understanding for whatever cause after due written notice to the other party given at least one (1) month prior to the intended date of termination.
